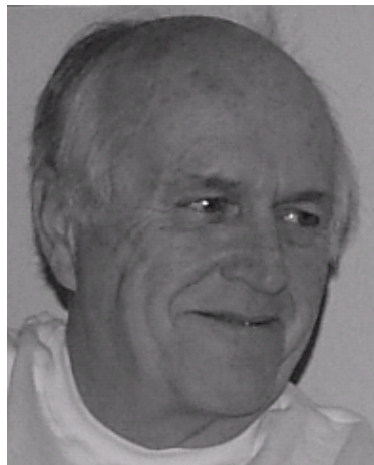

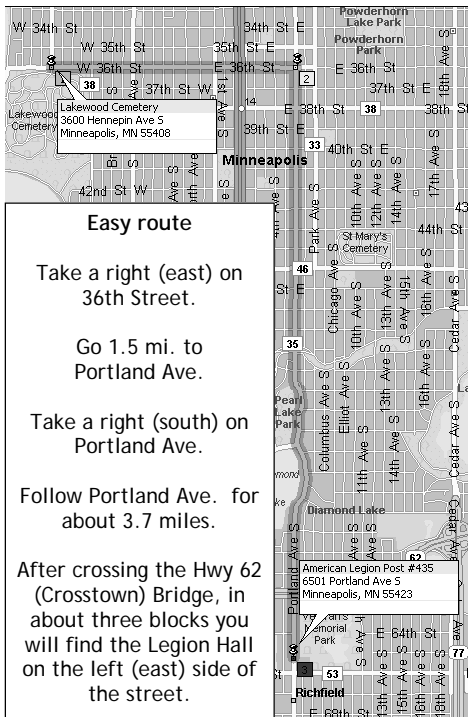

After crossing the Hwy 62 (Crosstown) Bridge, in about three blocks you will find the Legion Hall on the left (east) side of the street.

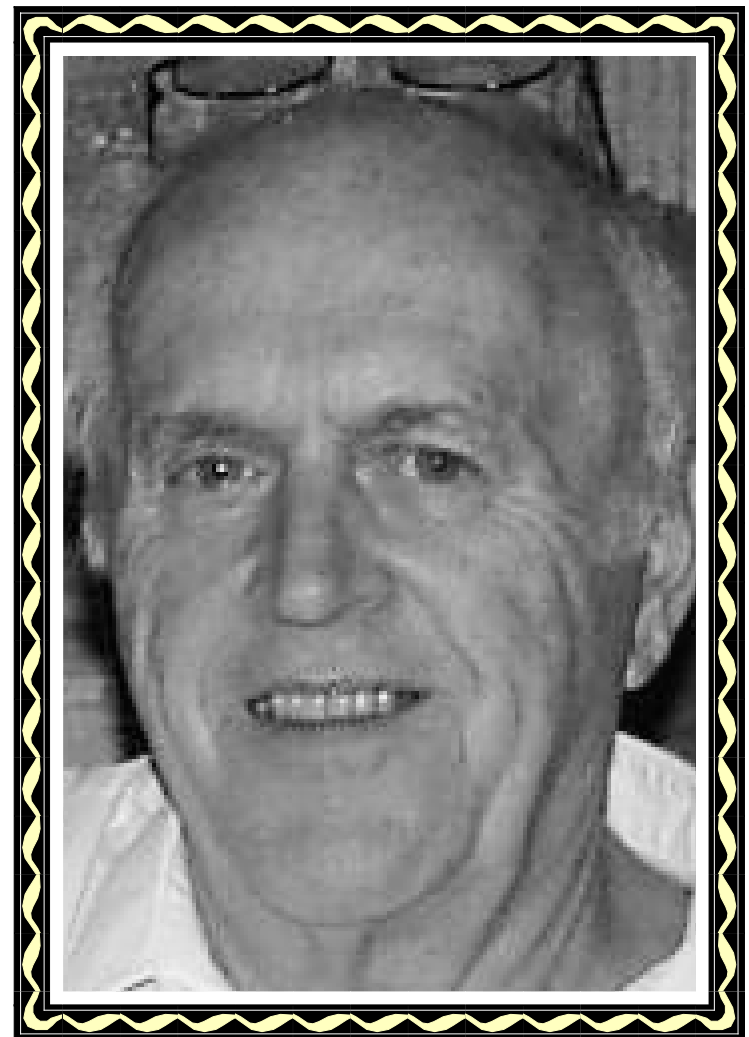
